

Use templates B11, B12, B13 and B14 to cut out each section of the colourful houses.



Matching the engineered corners sew the roof and door sections together.



Join all three sections of the house. Make 5 colourful houses.



Use templates B8, B11 and B13 to cut out each section of the grey houses.



Make the roof section and then sew the roof to the house. Make 10 grey houses.



Arrange and sew the house blocks into 3 rows with 5 houses in each row.

Sew $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of background fabric between each row and then sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the left and right sides. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $22\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of background fabric to the top and bottom to finish the mini quilt top.

Layer the mini quilt top, right side up, batting and backing fabric, right side down, to make a quilt sandwich. Baste using your favourite method and then quilt as desired. I straight line quilted my mini on a 45 degree angle.

Use three $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips of binding fabric to bind your quilt.
